What is The Cyber Career Pathways Tool?


The Cyber Career Pathways Tool presents a dynamic and exciting way to explore Work Roles within the NICE Workforce Framework for Cybersecurity (NICE Framework). The Tool highlights core attributes among each of the NICE Framework Work Roles and offers actionable insights for employers, professionals, and individuals considering a career in the cyber workforce.

The Cyber Career Pathways Tool allows users to explore individual Work Roles or compare two Work Roles to gain insight into the Tasks, Knowledge, and Skills (TKS) needed to be successful as well as potential certifications to pursue, educational requirements to consider, and related in-person and virtual training courses to register for.
